Please accept this as the request to amend NRC License 34-00054-07E. This license included the GE Lighting distribution centers located at the two locations listed below:

- 1) Kansas City Master Distribution Center
535 East 14th Avenue
North Kansas City, MO

- 2) Batesville Large Order Center
1736 Lammers Pike
Batesville, IN

The Kansas City facility is no longer operated as a distribution facility by GE Lighting. The Batesville facility only distributes incandescent lamps that do not contain any radioactive byproducts or sources. Both facilities should be removed from the list of distribution sites in the license item number 12. License item number 13 is therefore no longer applicable. Please refer to the storage license 34-00054-08 attached which was terminated in January 2004.

SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Ms. Kmiec:


In the letter dated September 22, 2003, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. Based on the information provided in letter dated September 22, 2003 and facsimile dated December 19, 2003, your facilities located in North Kansas City, Missouri and Batesville, Indiana are suitable for release.

During the review process, NRC learned that your Kansas City, Missouri facility was sold by GE Lighting several years ago. NRC approval to release the licensed facility for unrestricted use should have been obtained prior to the sale of that facility. While we have no objection to the transaction that occurred, failure to obtain NRC approval prior to releasing a licensed facility for unrestricted use is a violation of 10 CFR 30.36 (b). Since the quantity of licensed material stored at that facility was small and the material was contained in sealed shipping containers for re-distribution, we consider this a minor violation for which corrective action has been completed through the license termination process, and as such, the violation will not be cited. However, we caution you to ensure that future violations of this type do not recur at your other licensed facilities.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your NRC license number 34-00054-08 is hereby terminated.
