CFC LOGISTICS, INC.'S STATUS UPDATE REGARDING THE PRESIDING **OFFICER'S MARCH 16, 2004 ORDER**

In an attempt to solve the issues presented by Interveners in their March 15, 2004, Motion and to work toward an amicable solution to such issues, CFC Logistics, Inc. (CFC) has held internal discussions and discussions with relevant outside personnel to consider the reasons why the documents in CFC's March 5 and 12, 2004 submissions were labeled as confidential under the protective order. As a result of these discussions, CFC has reached the following conclusions:

- 1. CFC has no objection to releasing the brief and all attachments from CFC's March 12, 2004, submission regarding financial assurance from the protective order.
- 2. CFC is attempting to obtain permission from REVISS Services, Ltd. (REVISS) to disclose two exhibits from CFC's March 5, 2004, submission so that all aspects of that submission may be released from protective order. CFC notes that it does not have the power to release these documents from the protective order and must wait for REVISS to return a decision.
- 3. CFC has no objection to granting Interveners a reasonable time extension to seek the opinion of its expert and to respond to the NRC Staff and CFC submissions.

Given that the filing requested by the Presiding Officer in his March 16, 2004, Order depends greatly on whether or not REVISS does, in fact, grant CFC permission to disclose the aforementioned documents, CFC respectfully requests that the Presiding Officer grant CFC a brief time extension until 12 pm, Monday, March 22, 2004 to submit the requested filing so that CFC can attempt to reach an amicable solution and accommodate Interveners' request. Further, CFC respectfully requests that the Presiding Officer delay the conference call set for next Monday, March 22, 2004, between CFC and Interveners' counsel until such time as a decision from REVISS can be reached.
