**CFC LOGISTICS, INC.'S SECOND STATUS UPDATE REGARDING THE
PRESIDING OFFICER'S MARCH 16, 2004 ORDER**

In an attempt to solve the issues presented by Interveners in their March 15, 2004, Motion and to work toward an amicable solution to such issues, CFC Logistics, Inc. (CFC) has held internal discussions and discussions with relevant outside personnel to consider the reasons why the documents in CFC's March 5 and 12, 2004 submissions were labeled as confidential under the protective order.


On March 19, 2004, CFC submitted a Status Update to the Presiding Officer stating that CFC had no objection to releasing its March 12, 2004, brief and its attachment from the protective order and that CFC had no objection to allowing Interveners a reasonable time extension to respond to the NRC Staff and CFC submissions. In addition, CFC also informed the Presiding Officer that it was attempting to secure the permission of REVISS Services, Ltd. (REVISS), CFC's "sealed source" supplier, to release the March 5, 2004, brief and all its attachments from the aforementioned protective order. In the interim,

CFC has held additional discussions with REVISS and, as a result of these discussions, we have reached the following conclusions:

1. CFC has no objection to releasing the brief and all attachments from CFC's March 12, 2004, submission regarding financial assurance from the protective order.
2. CFC has obtained permission from REVISS to release the brief and all the attachments from CFC's March 5, 2004, submission. Thus, CFC has no objection to Interveners' request to release such submission from the protective order.
3. CFC has no objection to granting Interveners a reasonable time extension to seek the opinion of its expert and to respond to the NRC Staff and CFC submissions.

CFC asserts that each of Interveners' concerns regarding the public availability of the aforementioned documents have been resolved. As a result, CFC respectfully requests that Interveners' withdraw their March 15, 2004, or, in the alternative, that the Presiding Officer deny Interveners' request for sanctions.


