Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station Unit 2 was shutdown for Refuel Outage 17 (Q2R17) on February 24, 2004. In accordance with Technical Specifications Section 5.6.5.d, enclosed is the Core Operating Limits Report (COLR) for Quad Cities Unit 2 Cycle 18.

The Unit 2 COLR contains Global Nuclear Fuel (GNF) proprietary information that should be withheld from public disclosure.
