NOTICE OF PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF LICENSE AUTHORIZING CURTISS-WRIGHT CORPORATION TO OPERATE A RESEARCH REACTOR, DOCKET NO. 50-39

SYMBOL: LRL:CTE

I have submitted for publication in the Federal Register the attached notice of proposed issuance of a license authorizing Curtiss-Wright Corporation to operate its 1000-kilowatt pool-type reactor situated near Quahanna, Pennsylvania.

If no timely request for formal hearing is filed I will issue the license.

On March 5, 1958, a preoperational inspection of the reactor was conducted. The Division of Inspection reported that construction of the facility was complete with the exception that equipment had not yet been installed for cooling by forced circulation. The proposed license, therefore, incorporates a condition that the power level shall be limited to a maximum 100 kw until the forced circulation equipment has been installed.

The following additional actions are being taken:

- A. The JCAE is being advised by a letter to its Executive Director.
- B. A public announcement is being made.
- C. A copy of the notice and a copy of my memorandum setting forth the principal factors considered in reviewing the application are being sent to the applicant and all other persons on a service list of those entitled to or specifically requesting documents in these proceedings, including appropriate state officials and persons asking to be informed.
