CURTISS-WRIGHT CORPORATION - SEPTEMBER 30, 1957 VISIT

On September 30, James H. Thomas and Edward Kerzner of Curtiss-Wright Corporation, Quehanna, Pennsylvania met with Ely Brandes and myself. Also present was R. P. Summer of the Curtiss-Wright Washington office.

The visitors have been assigned responsibility for a survey to determine " the conmercial market for domestic and foreign nuclear power plants and associated fuel cycle services. Since they seemed particularly interested in the foreign market we suggested they arrange meetings with Charter Heslep, DIA, and B. B. Smyth, DCA.

We discussed the problems in forecasting nuclear electric power. They were given copies of the reactor list put out by Reactor Development, 10 CFR Part 110 and "Industry and International Cooperation." The McKinney Panel Report and the Raytheon reactor list were suggested. Mentioned the data we have available on UF₆ conversion needs of known reactors.

The visitors were obviously just getting started and were still in the process of orienting themselves.
