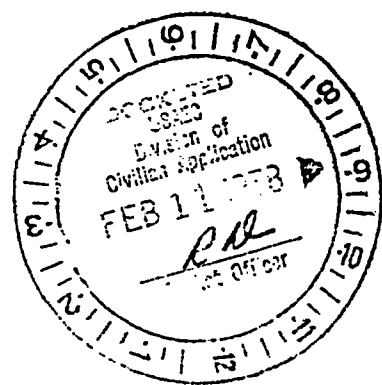
Enclosed please find ten (10) copies of report number CWR 400-2 entitled, "Hazards Evaluation Report, Curtiss-Wright Research Reactor."

NUCLEAR ENERGY LIABILITY INSURANCE BINDER NO. 13



Mutual Atomic Energy Liability Underwriters (herein called Underwriters), acting on behalf of its members, hereby binds nuclear energy liability insurance in favor of

with respect to the facility or operations described below, subject to the limit of liability and other terms of this binder:

1. Limit of Liability The total aggregate liability of Underwriters' members under this binder and any policy issued in replacement hereof is \$250,000 (part of \$250,000).
2. Description of Insurance Afforded Except with respect to cancelation, the insurance afforded by this binder shall be in accordance with the terms of the Nuclear Energy Liability Policy in use by Underwriters on the effective date of this binder. Issuance by Underwriters of a Nuclear Energy Liability Policy with respect to the facility or operations described below terminates this binder as of the effective date of such binder.
3. Premium The deposit premium stated below is payable at the time of acceptance of this binder. By acceptance of this binder the named insured agrees to pay Underwriters when billed the premium for the period of this binder, and the deposit premium paid shall be credited against such billed premium. Any premium paid under this binder shall be credited against the premium for any policy issued in replacement of this binder.
4. Cancelation of Binder This binder may be canceled either by the named insured or Underwriters by mailing to the other at its address stated in this binder, and to the Atomic Energy Commission, written notice stating when, not less than 30 days thereafter, such cancelation shall be effective. The mailing of notice as aforesaid shall be sufficient proof of notice. Delivery of such written notice shall be equivalent to mailing.

If the named insured cancels, the earned premium for this binder shall be computed in accordance with the customary short rate table and procedure; provided, if the named insured cancels after knowledge of a nuclear incident, all premiums theretofore paid or payable shall be fully earned. If Underwriters cancel, the earned premium for this binder shall be computed pro rata.

Nuclear Energy Liability Binder

Premium adjustment may be made either at the time cancelation is effected or as soon as practicable after cancelation becomes effective, but payment or tender of unearned premium is not a condition of cancelation.

5. Period of Binder Beginning at 12:01 A.M. on the first day of January, 1958, and continuing through March 31, 1958, standard time at the address of the named insured as stated herein, unless sooner terminated in accordance with the terms hereof. Such period may be extended for an additional period by endorsement issued by Underwriters to form a part thereof.
