Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the requirements of the Atomic Energy Commission Act and Regulations, a definition of the Reactor site is required in connection with the licensing of reactors. Curtiss-Wright Corporation's Reactor License No. R-36 incorporated by reference a description of its Reactor site as contained in its application for license and amendments thereto.

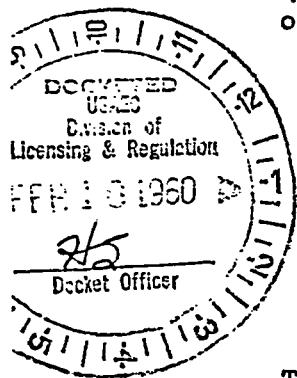
A survey of the Reactor site has since been obtained and Curtiss-Wright Corporation respectfully requests that its Reactor License No. R-36 be amended so as to substitute for prior descriptions of the Reactor site (as defined in the Atomic Energy Commission Act and Regulations) the following, namely:

DESCRIPTION OF REACTOR SITE

"The location of the Reactor site falls on the Karthaus, Pennsylvania Quadrangle of the United States Geological Survey. The description of the Reactor site is as follows:

BEGINNING at corner #1 having State Plane Coordinates X = 1,866,297, Y = 385,055; thence South 05° 14' 50" East, three hundred and nine and four tenths (309.4) feet; thence South 84° 45' 10" West, three hundred and eighty-five and six tenths (385.6) feet; thence North 05° 14' 50" West, three hundred and nine and four tenths (309.4) feet; thence North 84° 45' 10" East, three hundred and eighty-five and six tenths (385.6) feet to place of BEGINNING. CONTAINING 2.7 acres more or less.

The Reactor site is bounded on all sides by property owned or leased by Curtiss-Wright Corporation."
