This temporary assignment will probably last approximately 4-6 months.

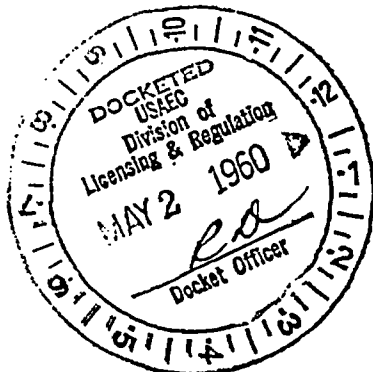
