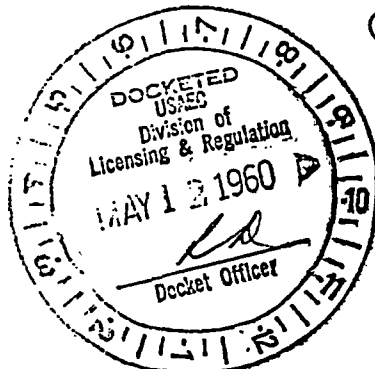

MUTUAL ATOMIC ENERGY LIABILITY UNDERWRITERS

INCREASE OF LIMIT OF LIABILITY ENDORSEMENT (After Prior Increase and Reduction)

It is agreed that:

1. The limit of liability stated in Item 4 of the declarations as amended by Endorsement No. 2, "Increase of Limit of Liability Endorsement", and by Endorsement No. 3, "Reduction of Limit of Liability Endorsement", is further amended to read \$1,500,000. This amended limit applies with respect to obligations assumed or expenses incurred because of bodily injury or property damage caused, during the period from the effective date of this endorsement to the date of termination of the policy, by the nuclear energy hazard.
2. The original limit of liability stated in Item 4 of the declarations, the limit of liability stated in paragraph 1 of Endorsement No. 2, the amended limit of liability stated in paragraph 3 of Endorsement 3 and the amended limit of liability stated in paragraph 1 above shall not be cumulative, and each payment made by the companies after the effective date of this endorsement for any loss or expense covered by the policy shall reduce by the amount of such payment the limit of liability originally stated in Item 4 of the declarations, the amended limit of liability stated in Endorsement No. 2, the amended limit of liability stated in Endorsement No. 3 and the amended limit of liability stated in paragraph 1 above, regardless of which limit of liability applies with respect to the bodily injury or property damage out of which such loss or expense arises.

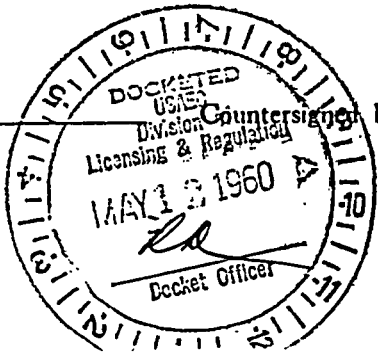

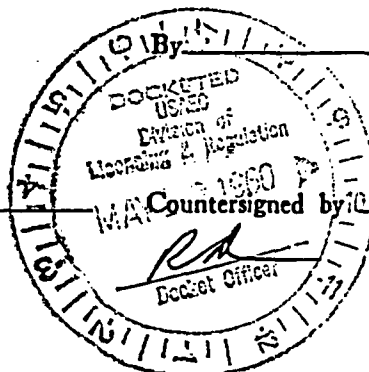
