Dear Governor Lawrence:

This is to inform you that the Atomic Energy Commission has issued Amendment No. 4 to Facility License No. K-36 issued to Curtiss-Wright Corporation. The amendment authorizes Curtiss-Wright to shut down the research reactor facility located at Quakama, Pennsylvania, for a period of one year and to maintain the facility on a stand-by basis during this period as requested in the Corporation's application for license amendment dated August 17, 1960.

Copies of the amendment to the license, a related notice submitted to the Office of the Federal Register for publication, and a related AEC hazards analysis are enclosed.

A copy of this letter, with enclosures, is being sent to the Department of Labor and Industry, the Pennsylvania Department of Health, and the Bureau of Environmental Health for their information.
