Dear Mr. Laffler:

This refers to Mr. H. L. Price's letter to you of December 21, 1959 which concerned a letter you forwarded from Mr. T. M. McKinney of the Mosquito Creek Sportsmen's Association regarding the discharge of water into Mosquito Creek as it relates to atomic energy installations.

This matter has been investigated and the results indicate that any discharges of radioactive material into Mosher Run, which flows into Mosquito Creek, by the Curtiss Wright Corp., Quakertown, Pennsylvania, the firm involved, is being done in accordance with Atomic Energy Commission regulations and does not present a hazard to public health and safety.
