Dear Mr. Loeffler:

This refers to my letter to you of December 31, 1959 which concerned a letter you forwarded from Mr. T. M. McKinney of the Mosquito Creek Sportsmen's Association regarding the discharge of water into Mosquito Creek as it relates to atomic energy installations.

This matter has been fully investigated by the Division of Compliance of the AEC and the results of this investigation indicate that any discharges of radioactive material into Meeker Run, which flows into Mosquito Creek, by the Curtiss Wright Corp., Quakman, Pennsylvania, the firm involved, is being done in accordance with Atomic Energy Commission regulations and does not present a hazard to public health and safety.
