This is to inform you that this matter has been investigated and the results indicate that any discharges of radioactive material into Mosker Run, which flows into Mosquito Creek, by the Curtiss Wright Corp., Coahoma, Pennsylvania, the firm involved, is being done in accordance with Atomic Energy Commission regulations and does not present a hazard to public health and safety.
