Dear Senator Sununu:

The Vermont nuclear power plant should now be closed, not allowed to increase its capacity by 20 percent. The fact that the Price Anderson Law forbids anyone from suing for damages in case of a nuclear accident clearly shows how unsafe nuclear plants can be. Even our homeowner's insurance policies exclude collecting damages caused by nuclear accidents.

There is no solution for the deposit of nuclear fuel rods. I believe there are many more of these rods stored at the plant than were initially authorized.

Please take these facts into consideration and do everything in your power to protect the people and places that would be seriously and adversely affected by a catastrophic nuclear disaster which appears to be imminent, particularly if its power capacity were increased!
