Dear Ms. Kray:

By letter dated October 27, 2003, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) accepted the application of Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon) for an early site permit (ESP) for the Clinton ESP site. That letter also contained the NRC's planned review schedule for the application.

Based on the NRC staff's review of the application, and discussions with Mr. Thomas Mundy and Mr. William Maher of your staff, we have reached a mutually agreeable revised date for the NRC's transmittal of the environmental requests for additional information (RAI). The revised date is May 14, 2004. The enclosed schedule has been revised to reflect the new date.

As discussed with your staff, we do not believe the revised date requires any changes to the subsequent milestones in the review schedule.
