Dear Mr. Kosey:

The Atomic Energy Commission has issued license No. A-72 to the Pennsylvania State University authorizing the University to possess, but not to operate, the nuclear research reactor facility at the Curtiss-Wright Research and Development Center at Johnstown, Pennsylvania. This facility has heretofore been owned by the Curtiss-Wright Corporation, and previously operated under license No. A-36. On the effective date of this license, Curtiss-Wright will transfer ownership of this facility to the Pennsylvania State University and Curtiss-Wright license No. A-36 will be terminated.

Enclosed for your information are a copy of license No. A-72, a notice of issuance of facility license, which has been submitted to the Office of the Federal Register for filing and publication and a related hazard analysis prepared by the Research and Power Reactor Safety branch of the Division of Licensing and Regulation. Also enclosed is a notice of termination of license No. A-36, issued to Curtiss-Wright Corporation.
