Subject: Guidance for Screening NRC Documents for Sensitive Information

I have been tasked by Marty Virgilio to develop staff guidance for screening NRC products (SEs, EISs, NUREGs, etc) for the presence of sensitive information. Such screened information will be subject to redacting from publically available versions of NRC documents.

Currently, NMSS (SFPO) is preparing an FEIS and supplemental SERs for Private Fuel Storage, a large, away-from-reactor ISFSI, and we need to effectively screen these documents before they are made public. NMSS management suggested that we share with other offices our thought process for screening to solicit comments and input to ensure that the guidance that we prepare and use could also be used by other NRC offices in the near term.

Therefore, could you assign a contact person that could work with me to provide comments on what NMSS is doing or to share information on what process or guidance your office has been using to screen recent products. I have attached:

- (1) a preliminary list of 17 types of information that would be subject to redaction. The list was based on a review of our SRP for ISFSIs and the contents of the FEIS.
- (2) the same list with suggested detailed examples of sensitive information.
