By letter dated June 26, 1998, the NRC issued a Confirmatory Order Modifying License (Order) for the Clinton Power Station (CPS). The subject order required IP to complete final implementation of Thermo-Lag 330-1 fire barrier corrective actions at CPS as described in the June 19, 1997 and March 30, 1998, submittals (IP letters U-602762 and U-602962 respectively) to the NRC, in addition to the repair of the butt joint described in the March 28, 1995, submittal (IP letter U-602435) to the NRC, by December 31, 1998. Via letter U-603122 dated December 7, 1998, IP requested that the December 31, 1998, due date for completing the activities required by the subject Confirmatory Order be relaxed such that completion of these activities would be required prior to startup of CPS from the current outage. This request was made via IP letter U-603122 dated December 7, 1998. By letter dated December 23, 1998, the NRC approved the completion date change requested by IP in letter U-603122.

The purpose of this letter is to provide notification that IP has completed Thermo-Lag 330-1 fire barrier corrective actions as described in IP letters U-602762 and U-602962, in addition to the repair of the butt joint described in IP letter U-602435.
