My rationale is:

After reviewing this document, the information does not contain any "SAFEGUARDS INFORMATION". The site specific technical information in this document does not reveal any useful information for security concern to the nuclear power plants after the events of Sept 11, 2001. Even the specific failure modes of fuses and holders could affect the function of protected electrical equipment, circuit, or other devices, the delivered acts to cause the failure by the outsiders are not considered as creditable threat to the nuclear security based on the information in this document. The significance of aging characteristics is the primary concern for this NUREG.
