We seek information concerning the Martin Company, subsequently known as Martin Marietta Company, and now known as Lockheed Martin Corporation, who leased the Quehanna Nuclear Reactor Facility from The Pennsylvania State University from 1962-1967. Martin Marietta Company obtained a Byproduct Materials License from the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission on June 26, 1962. The license number is 19-1398-29 (F64).

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, and 10 C.F.R. Part 9, we hereby request copies of the following materials:

1. (a) Byproduct Materials License 19-1398-29 (F64) and any other byproduct materials licenses relating to the facility.
- (b) Any source material or special nuclear material licenses relating to the facility.
- (c) All applications submitted to obtain the above licenses.
2. Any reports, assessments, memoranda, letters, bills, invoices or other communications concerning any indemnification agreements relating to the facility provided by the U.S. government pursuant to contract or the Price Anderson Act.
3. Any reports, memoranda, letters or other communications concerning radioactive waste disposal or residual radioactive contamination by or relating to Martin Marietta Company and now known as Lockheed Martin Corporation.
