The subject Generic Letter (GL) 92-08 dated December 17, 1992, requested Licensees respond within 120 days with additional information regarding Thermo-Lag 330-1 fire barrier systems. Accordingly, Philadelphia Electric Company (PECo) responded on April 16, 1993. In that response, PECo committed to submitting, by the end of 1993, a report detailing the status of our Thermo-Lag corrective action program.
