NUMEROUS BWIP TECHNICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

SUMMARY

(1) GEOLOGY/GEOPHYSICS DATA REVIEW - DOE MANAGEMENT (J. MEICA, D. DAHLEM) & WESTINGHOUSE OFFICIALS, CITING SLP REVISION PRIORITIES (RESULTING FROM THE LICENSING ASSURANCE REVIEW BOARD SLP COMMENTS) HAVE CONCLUDED THAT A DATA REVIEW CANNOT BE SUPPORTED FOR THE AUG. 10 - AUG. 14, 1987 TIME PERIOD. OTHER DECISIONS INCLUDE:

(A) THE DATA REVIEW, CONSIDERING THE TIME SET ASIDE FOR PRESENTATIONS AND Q's 'A's, WILL BE RESCHEDULED, BUT WILL BE CONSIDERED AS A WORKSHOP.

(B) THE AGENDA, DEVELOPED FOR THE DATA REVIEW, WILL BE FOLLOWED, WITH MODIFICATION, AS APPROPRIATE, FOR THE WORKSHOP.

(C) SEPTEMBER, WITH NO SPECIFIC TIME FRAME, WAS PRESENTED AS A POSSIBILITY FOR WORKSHOP SCHEDULING.

(D) THE GEOLOGY/GEOPHYSICS CONCERNS OF APRIL 3 RELATIVE TO THE HYDROLOGIC TESTING PROGRAM WILL BE ADDRESSED AT THE WORKSHOP.

(E) THE DOE WILL BE LOOKING AT A 3-DAY SESSION.

(F) DOE/NRC, WILL MAINTAIN DIALOGUE IN DEVELOPING THE AGENDA FOR THE GEOLOGY/GEOPHYSICS WORKSHOP.

(2) FIELD TRIP - NRC INDICATED THAT STEPS ARE BEING TAKEN TO SPONSOR A VANIMA FOLD BELT GEOLOGIC FIELD TRIP TO BE LED BY DR. P. BENTLEY OF CENTRAL WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY AT ELLENBURG. PRELIMINARY INDICATIONS ARE FOR A 3-DAY TRIP TO INCLUDE STOPS AT LOCALES DEMONSTRATING SUGGESTIONS OF QUATERNARY FAULTING AND RATES OF DEFORMATION FOR THE VANIMA FOLD BELT. IT IS ANTICIPATED

THAT THE FIELD TRIP WILL TAKE PLACE THE WEEK OF AUGUST 3 PROBABLY COMMENCING AT ELLENBURG WITH AN ORIENTATION BY DR. BENTLEY. DOE, AS WELL AS THE STATE & AFFECTED TRIBES ARE INVITED ON THE TRIP. DOE, IN PARTICULAR, IS ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE AS A MEANS TO INITIATE RESOLUTION OF SOME OF THE GEOLOGICAL ISSUES FACING US.

(3) HYDROLOGY RESTART PACKAGE:

(A) DOE ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE RESTART PACKAGE IS DEFICIENT IN THAT PROCEDURES DESCRIBING DOE'S ABILITY TO IDENTIFY STRATIGRAPHIC UNITS HAVE NOT YET BEEN DEVELOPED.

(B) DOE WISHES TO KNOW HOW MUCH OF AN ISSUE WILL BE MADE BY THE URL OF THIS ACKNOWLEDGED SHORT-COMING.

(C) DOE WILL BE ADDRESSING THIS SHORT-COMING IN THE HYDROLOGY "CONFERENCE" MEETING WHICH WILL FOLLOW DOE'S RECEIPT AND ACTION TAKEN AS A RESULT OF RECEIPT OF "RESTART PACKAGE COMMENTS".

(4) FUTURE DATA REVIEWS - AS ON SEVERAL PREVIOUS OCCASIONS, DOE FAVORABLY COMMENTED ON THE QUALITY OF THE MAY 11-17, 1987 BOREHOLE DATA REVIEW IN WHICH JIM WARREN PARTICIPATED. THIS DATA REVIEW WAS WELCOMED BY DOE IN THAT THERE WAS A FREE FLOW OF INFORMATION WITH VERY LITTLE IMPACT ON DOE'S PERSONNEL. DOE ENCOURAGES FUTURE DATA REVIEWS OF THIS TYPE.
