The issue is the need to come to grips with specific regulations in 10 CFR that mandate the posting of certain specified documents on the web (e.g., organization charts, license renewal applications, license transfer applications).

Steve, after receiving clearance from the web review committee, the web staff was asked to post 10CFR in its entirety. I understand this will occur very shortly. I am copying Fran Goldberg on this e-mail to identify it as a priority posting. This should solve our problem.

Mindy - the attachment is a survey of NRC regulations to identify those that include a reference to posting documents or information on the NRC website. We have identified those regulations which mandate by regulation the availability of certain information through the website. It seems to me that these categories of documents should gain some priority over restoration of other aspects of the website - even with respect to such things as ongoing rulemakings. NRR and our staff are facing issues in real time regarding the posting of such matters as license renewal applications (see the attached e-mail) and license transfer applications.

If these materials are not restored, normally established review schedules will be affected. In most instances, it appears that the primary documents to be posted would not be captured by the lower threshold restrictions on general release.
