Release 3 of the NRC's Redesigned Public Web Site Now Available

Release 3 of our redesigned public web site is now available at www.nrc.gov. This marks the third step in our plan to deploy the remainder of the site in a phased approach early in 2002. See the What's New page at <http://www.nrc.gov/site-help/new-content.html> for the schedule and content of Release 4, the final phase of the redesigned site.

Release 3 includes new material for Nuclear Reactors, Nuclear Materials, and Radioactive Waste, as well as What We Do and the Electronic Reading Room. Within the reactor section, additional material is included for Facilities, Licensing, Oversight, and Operational Experience. Release 3 adds much new Radioactive Waste material and, under What We Do, restored content on Allegations. This release also includes the first release of the site-wide subject Index.

Some information is still not available because of content reviews subsequent to the events of September 11, 2001. Information not yet available continues to be shown as "blacked-out" links.
