Release 4 of the NRC's Redesigned Public Web Site Now Available

Release 4 of our redesigned public Web site is now available at www.nrc.gov. This marks the fourth step in our plan to deploy the remainder of the site in a phased approach early in 2002.

What We Do has been greatly expanded and includes, among other areas, Commission Activities; Rulemaking, Generic Communications, Standards Development; Inspection, Assessment of Performance, Enforcement, Investigations, Allegations; Licensing and Certification; Emergency Response, Events Assessment, Generic Issues; Research, Advisory Activities, Adjudication; and Congressional Affairs, State and Tribal Programs, and International Programs.

Additional Information on **Nuclear Reactors** includes Power Upgrades, Fitness for Duty, and Operator Licensing Generic Fundamentals Examinations.

For **Nuclear Materials**, the new content includes Sealed Sources and Devices; Product Manufacturing and Distribution; Medical Uses; Veterinary Uses; Industrial Uses; Academic and Research Uses; Exempt Consumer Product Uses; Licensee Toolkits for all categories of materials licensees; Orphan Sources; and Medical Use of Byproduct Material (Part 35).

Additional information in the **Electronic Reading Room** includes the new Electronic Hearing Docket; Regulatory Issues Summaries issued in 2001; selected Regulatory Guides in Division 1; and a focused search capability for the 10 CFR Collection.

The **Site Glossary** has been restored and the **Site Index** and **Site Map** have been updated.

As with past releases, some information is still not available because of content reviews subsequent to the events of September 11, 2001. Information not yet available continues to be shown as "blacked-out" links.
