## SUBJECT: 2004 PROPOSED FEES & HEARING DATE

We are proposing to adjust our fees for radioactive materials licenses to meet necessary program costs. The annual fees and the license application fee are proposed to increase approximately 3% (individually ranging from 2.74 % to 3.20%, which is within the fiscal growth factor for the 2004 fiscal year). This proposed rule provides small increases in the fees that are necessary to meet anticipated program costs and maintain the current level of program's ervices of the Radioactive Materials Program.

A summary of the proposed radioactive materials license fees is attached. The full text of the proposed fee change is being published in the Washington State Register (WSR 04-07-175). The proposed rules are also available at our web site under "Rules & Regulations"; "New and Proposed Regulations". Go to http://www.doh.wa.gov/ehp/rp.

A public hearing on the proposed radioactive materials fees will be held on April 27, 2004, at 10:00 AM in Building 5, 7171 Cleanwater Lane, Tumwater, WA (Exit 101 from I-5, go 1 mile east on Tumwater Blvd., turn left on Cleanwater Lane, left at second drive). Comments must be received by April 27, 2004, to assure consideration.
