I recently read in an article on ABCNews.com that the NRC had shutdown its web site in the interest of preventing sensitive information from being accessed by the public. KEEP IN MIND that some search engines, particularly <http://www.google.com/>, CACHE web pages that they index. In other words, if Google has indexed pages from the NRC site for its users to search, it keeps a COPY of each NRC page it indexes on its servers, which are publicly accessible and which potentially contain sensitive information.

I did a quick search on Google's site and did find the "cached" link unavailable for a couple NRC links that turned up, so it seems as though someone has taken care of this. But my search was in no way comprehensive and therefore I felt obligated to inform you of this potential problem.
