This letter forwards NRC Form 591, "Safety Inspection," indicating that no items of non-compliance were found during the inspection of your licensed material that was stored at 2702 Paoli Pike, No.152, New Albany, Indiana. Please retain the form in your files.

During the inspection March 26, 2004, the inspector determined that your staff possessed an NDC System Gamma Gauge, Model 104P, Serial No. 11121, containing 2.96 gigabecquerel of Americium-241, a gauge that must be possessed and used pursuant to the general license described in Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 31.5 (enclosed). Please be advised that as a General Licensee you are required to abide by these regulations and the conditions of use specified by the gauge manufacturer. You may only dispose of the gauge by transfer to an authorized recipient.
