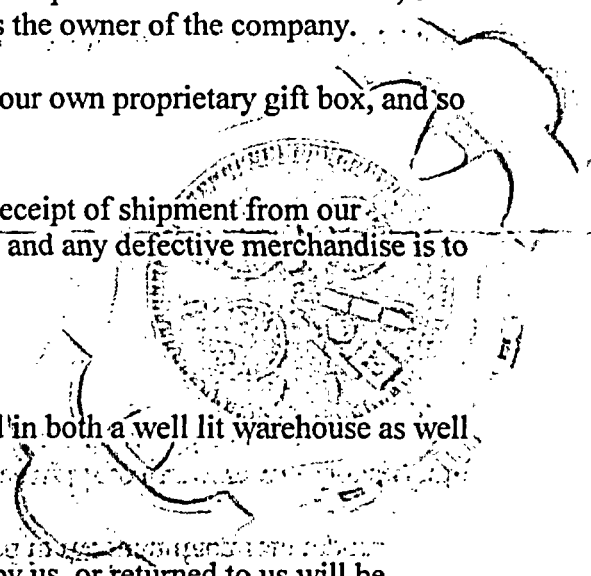

Dear Mr. Kirkwood,

Regarding the concerns that were indicated in our telephone conversation of February 4, I would like to answer your questions.

1. Visual checks for defects:
 - A. Our watches will have a 3 point inspection. The first check is at the manufacturing level. All watches will be thoroughly inspected prior to shipment from the factory, as outlined in the manufacturers report.
 - B. All watches will be inspected upon receipt into our own warehouse, both by the warehouse manager as well as the owner of the company.
 - C. All watches will be repackaged into our own proprietary gift box, and so will be individually inspected.
 - D. All watches will be inspected upon receipt of shipment from our warehouse by the authorized dealer, and any defective merchandise is to be returned immediately to us.
2. Methods of leak detection:
 - A. All tritium watches will be inspected in both a well lit warehouse as well as darkened room for leak detection.
3. Disposal of defects:
 - B. All defective merchandise received by us, or returned to us will be carefully packaged and returned to factory.


4. NRC Sales reports:

 - A. We are currently in process of communicating with the State of CA to acquire our state license.
