SUBJECT: MARCH 22, 2004, AP1000 TELEPHONE CONFERENCE CALL
SUMMARY

On Monday, March 22, 2004, a telephone conference call was held with Westinghouse Electric Company (Westinghouse) representatives and Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff to discuss issues related to security features. The NRC staff specifically discussed open item (OI) 13.6-1, which was raised by the NRC in a letter dated June 4, 2003 (ADAMS Accession No. ML031480333). Westinghouse responded to this open item by letter dated July 1, 2003 (ML031950553), and provided OI 13.6-1 response Rev. 1 by letter dated February 2, 2004 (ML040370767). A list of call participants is included in Attachment 1.

The following is a brief summary of the discussion regarding the staff's request for additional information concerning OI 13.6-1:

- A) The staff stated that the location of the central alarm system (CAS), secondary alarm system (SAS), and the emergency power system should be indicated in the AP1000 Security Assessment Document;
- B) Westinghouse informed the staff they would be submitting a revised response to OI 13.6-1 by March 26, 2004;
- C) Westinghouse committed to change the non-safeguards information in Revision 1 of AP1000 Security Assessment Document; and

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- D) Westinghouse also committed to change the safeguards information in Revision 1 of AP1000 Security Assessment Document to include the location of the CAS, SAS, and the emergency power system, as soon as possible.
