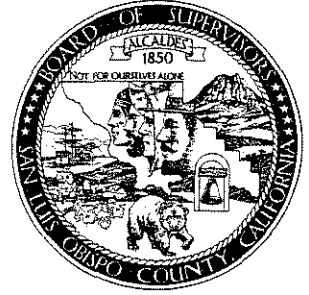

On April 20, 2004 the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors will be hearing an appeal of the Planning Commission's decision to grant Pacific Gas and Electric Company a Coastal Development Permit (CDP) to construct an Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation Facility (ISFSI) at Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant.
