<u>Frequency of Response:</u> On occasion

Number of Respondents: 8

Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses: The overall burden increased by 4 hours from 443 to 447 hours. The reporting burden increased by 5 hours from 333 to 338 hours, because of the incorporation of Section 95.39(d), which was inadvertently omitted from the previous clearance package. However, the burden for Section 95.33(d) was miscalculated and should have been 12 hours instead of 15. Therefore, the reporting burden hours increased by a net of only 2 hours, totaling 335 hours. The recordkeeping burden increased by 2 hours from 110 to 112 hours because of the incorporation of Sections 95.13, 95.19(c), 95.37(e)(2); and 95.37(f) which were inadvertently omitted from the previous clearance package. The hourly rates increased from \$143/hr. to \$157/hr. for professional effort in accordance with Part 170 and from \$45/hr. to \$60/hr. for clerical effort.
