

Subject: Condition of TMI 2 pressure vessel



## Dear NRC.

I have before me what I think is a Press Release from the NRC files, No. 93-145. It is dated October 5, 1993. It announces a meeting with NRC participation to present the findings and conclusions of the Three Mile Island Unit 2 Vessel Investigation Project. The meeting was to be held in Boston October 20-22. Commissioner Rogers was to give the opening address. The meeting was open to the public. I have not been able to find any record of the proceedings of the meeting or of the results of the vessel investigation. I have searched the NRC data base and the TMI data base at Pennsylvania State University but It is possible that I missed something.

I am requesting any information that bears on the question of how much damage the TMI 2 pressure vessel actually sustained, how close it was to failure, and whether or not it would have failed if 100% of the core had melted. If the information I seek is not in the NRC files but exists somewhere else I would appreciate being pointed in the right direction.
