The purpose of this modification is to: (1) incorporate, by reference, Modification No. 000001 to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' contract number 500-02-0008, dated March 15, 2004, which incorporated the Novation Agreement, effective January 1, 2003, between JW Associates, LLC (Transferor), Innovative Technology Group, Inc. (Transferee), and the United States of America (Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, on behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission) under the authority contained in FAR Subpart 42.1204, thereby modifying the subject contract and modifications thereto, to indicate that Innovative Technology Group, Inc., is the Successor-in-Interest to JW Associates, LLC, and (2) revise the Statement of Work to add new work entitled, "Acquisition of Conference Meeting Space for NRC's 2005, 2006, and 2007 Regulatory Information Conferences (RICs)." Accordingly, the contract is modified as follows:

- (1) **Block 7 of Standard Form 26 is deleted entirely and replaced with the following:**

"7. Name and Address of the Contractor (Transferee):

- (2) **Block 15G of Standard Form 26 is deleted entirely and replaced with the following:**

"15G. Total Amount of Contract: \$913,286.40."

- (3) **Under Section B.3 Consideration and Obligation—Task Orders, paragraph (a) is deleted entirely and replaced with the following:**

"(a) The total estimated amount of this contract (ceiling) for the products/services ordered, delivered, and accepted under this contract is \$913,286.40. The Contracting Officer may unilaterally increase this amount as necessary for orders to be placed with the Contractor during the contract period provided such orders are within any maximum ordering limitation prescribed under this contract. "

- (4) **Under Section B.3 Consideration and Obligation—Task Orders, add the following paragraphs:**

"(f) The total estimated cost to the Government for the acquisition of conference meeting space for RIC 2005 is \$236,632.94.

(g) The total estimated cost to the Government for the acquisition of conference meeting space for RIC 2006 is \$236,740.74.

(h) The total estimated cost to the Government for the acquisition of conference meeting space for RIC 2007 is \$259,403.92"

- (5) Under Section C - Description/Specifications/Statement of Work, add SubSection C.12 as follows:

**"C.12 ACQUISITION OF CONFERENCE MEETING SPACE FOR NRC's 2005, 2006, AND 2007 REGULATORY INFORMATION CONFERENCES (RICs)**

- (a) Independently and not as an agent of the Government, the Contractor shall furnish the conference facility, and all necessary services, qualified personnel, material, and equipment, not otherwise provided by the Government for NRC's Regulatory Information Conferences to be held in 2005, 2006, and 2007.
- (b) As this is a task ordering contract, the total estimated cost (ceiling) for the acquisition of the conference space for RICs 2005, 2006, and 2007 is \$732,921.80.
- (c) NRC will issue a new task order with a definitive Statement of Work for each RIC.
- (d) NRC will provide notification as to whether or not the Contractor shall acquire conference space for RICs 2006 and 2007, no later than March 18, 2005."

As a result of this modification the contract ceiling amount is increased by \$732,921.80 from \$180,364.60 to \$913,286.40. All other terms and conditions remain the same.
