SUMMARY

By application dated March 16, 2004, Packaging Technology, Inc., requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9184, Model No. PAS-1 package. Packaging Technology, Inc., did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents. The certificate has been renewed for a five year term.

EVALUATION

By application dated March 16, 2004, Packaging Technology, Inc., requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9184 for the Model No. PAS-1 package. Packaging Technology, Inc., did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents. The staff reviewed the documents referenced in the certificate and determined that the documentation was available and complete. The staff also reviewed the operating and maintenance procedures for the package and found them to be adequate.

Condition No. 7 of the certificate was revised to clarify that the package is approved for use under the general license provisions of 10 CFR 71.12, until October 1, 2004, and under the provisions of 10 CFR 71.17, thereafter. This change is due to a revision in the numbering of the sections in 10 CFR Part 71, that becomes effective on October 1, 2004 (69 FR 3698).

The address on the certificate was updated, at the request of Packaging Technology, Inc.

CONCLUSION

The certificate has been issued with an expiration date of July 31, 2009. This change does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
