I join with Chairman Diaz and Commissioner Merrifield in commending the staff for their efforts in crafting this performance-based alternative approach to the existing NRC regulations in the risk significant area of fire protection. I approve the recommendation by the staff to publish the notice of final rule and interim enforcement discretion in the <u>Federal Register</u>, subject to the following editorial correction:

- Attachment 1, Page 18, the sentence beginning on Line 6 should read:

"NFPA 805, Chapter 1, states the radioactive release performance criteria to maintain radiation release from the effects of fire suppression activities as low as reasonably achievable and not to exceed 10 CFR Part 20 limits."
