SUBJECT: SUPPORT STAFF REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ADVISORY
COMMITTEES ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS AND NUCLEAR
WASTE

The Commission has reviewed the support staff organization for the Advisory Committees on Reactor Safeguards and Nuclear Waste provided in your August 3, 1989 memorandum. We note that you have eliminated two positions and created two new positions. The Commission believes the proposed organization could be further streamlined and that at least two positions and one FTE could be eliminated to bring the organization into conformance with the 38 FTEs authorized by the Commission. To accomplish that streamlining, the Commission suggests that you consider eliminating either the Deputy Executive Director or Assistant to Executive Director position and that you consider combining the two Project Review Branches, since they essentially perform the same function. As an alternative to the organization you propose, consideration should be given to establishing an Assistant Executive Director for Reactors and Nuclear Waste, with a Reactors Branch and a Waste Branch reporting to this individual.

After consideration of these suggestions and how you plan to eliminate two positions and one FTE from your proposed organization, report back to the Commission on the organization you plan to implement.
