On September 1, 1972, I telephoned Mr. J. David McGraw, licensee's RSO. I reminded him of his commitment to submit a complete report on the recent flood damage at the Bloomsburg facility (see his letter dated June 29, 1972). McGraw stated that his submission of the report had been delayed pending management resolution of several proposals to prevent future loss of liquid waste through flood conditions. He stated that his further evaluations of the loss of the tritium waste had not given him any reason to change his June 29 statement of the relevant facts. He estimated that the final report, indicating corrective action, would be submitted by October 1.
