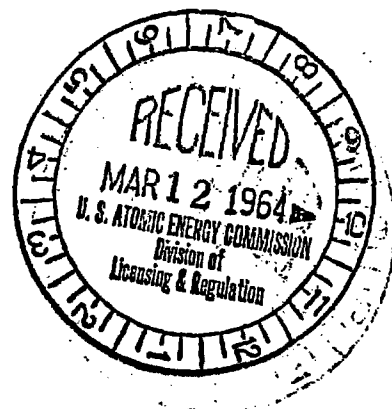
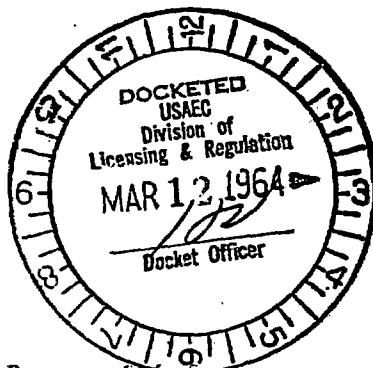

Gentlemen:

The University has accepted and I enclose one completely signed copy of Amendment No. 1 and Amendment No. 2 to Indemnity Agreement No. E-10.

In accepting these amendments, I have been asked by Dr. F. J. Remick, Director of our Reactor Facility, to request that the Indemnity Agreement be further amended to include as an integral part of the general Reactor Bay area the control room (noted CONT. ROOM on the attached map) and Counting Laboratory (noted LAB. on the attached map). These really should have been included as a part of the general Bay area under Amendments No. 1 and 2; but, considering that Amendment No. 1 has been pending for so long because of its having been misplaced, we are signing these two documents as submitted to us and thereby indicating their acceptability to us except for the foregoing requested change.

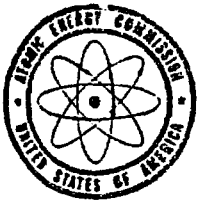

AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. E-10

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Effective at 12:01 A.M., April 19, 1963, Indemnity Agreement No. E-10 between The Pennsylvania State University and the Atomic Energy Commission dated October 8, 1962 is hereby amended as follows:

Item 3 of the Attachment to the indemnity agreement is amended with respect to License No. R-2 by deleting the definition of, location and substituting the following therefor:


Item 3 - Location

For purposes of License No. R-2:

The area, approximately 200 x 250 feet, encircled by a chain link fence providing a restricted area around the reactor building and all the facilities and buildings included therein. And from August 28, 1961, the area as modified by partitioning off a portion of the North corner for roadway purposes. These areas are further depicted in a drawing submitted by the University September 14, 1961 and entitled, "Proposed Campus Road to Provide Access Between S. Entrance Road and S. University Road" dated April 18, 1961, which drawing is made part of this indemnity agreement by reference. And from April 19, 1963 the location is further modified by excluding all of the additions authorized under CPRR-71 with the exception of the storage room on the basement floor and the laboratory, east of the reactor pool, on the first floor. This change is further delineated in Figure 1 attached to the University's letter of October 30, 1962 in which Figure the building areas included within the indemnified location appear as the cross-hatched areas and the areas marked off in red. This Figure 1 is made part of the indemnity agreement by reference.



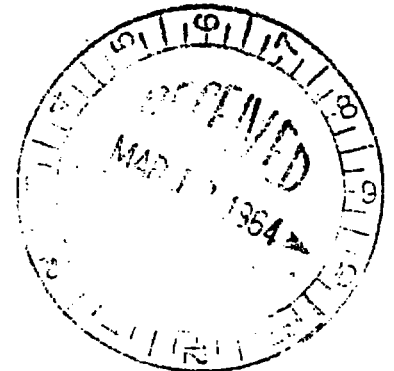
