ORDER

(Granting Motion for Further Extension of Time)

By May 7, 2004 joint motion, the Licensee Sequoyah Fuels Corporation and the Petitioners, State of Oklahoma and Cherokee Nation, request a further adjustment in the schedule for the filing of the written presentations in this materials licensing proceeding. The motion is said to be unopposed by the NRC Staff, the other party to the proceeding, and is based upon the fact that the parties will be meeting shortly to consider a settlement proposal that might obviate the need for further proceedings in this matter.

The motion seeks but a one-week extension of each phase of the current schedule. To provide a greater opportunity to conclude the on-going settlement negotiations without the need to seek yet another extension, the schedule is, however, being enlarged sua sponte by a period of two weeks.

Thus, the motion is granted and the current schedule for the filing of the written presentations is revised as follows:

May 28, 2004 Written Presentations of the Petitioners

June 25, 2004 Responsive Written Presentations of the Licensee and NRC Staff

July 9, 2004 Rebuttal Written Presentations of the Petitioners
