Dear Mr. Avery:

I am responding to your letter dated April 28, 2004, addressed to Mr. Allen G. Howe, then Acting Director of this Project Directorate. Your letter referred to the second paragraph of the April 6, 2004, letter Mr. Howe sent to Mr. D. J. Hennessy of the Board of Chosen Freeholders, County of Ocean, NJ. Specifically you asked us to provide information on those Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station (OCNGS) issues that were characterized as "integrity issues."

During the construction phase of a nuclear power plant such as OCNGS, issues were identified by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). NRC ensured that these issues were acceptably resolved, and their resolution documented, before an operating license is issued. For OCNGS, NRC's review for issuance of an operating license, including resolution of issues, was documented in the Safety Evaluation of December 23, 1968 (Enclosure 1), and two addenda, dated April 9 and August 1, 1969 (Enclosures 2 and 3), respectively. Note that these documents did not characterize issues as those involving "integrity" or not involving "integrity."
