Dear Dr. Kuo:

We are transmitting to you our proposed method for updating the GALL report, NUREG-1801. Comparisons of the plant to NUREG-1801 aging management review (AMR) results have been hampered by the differences in the format and content of the results presentations. This document proposes changes to NUREG-1801 in the format and content of the AMR results tables presented in Volume 2. The objective of the proposed changes is to increase the number of direct matches between the AMR results of future plant license renewal applications and NUREG-1801 which should reduce the NRC review time required for the applications.

The changes proposed (listed below and attached) vary for different chapters of the NUREG-1801, Volume 2, depending on the suitability of the current tables for comparisons.

- Suggested changes to NUREG-1801, Volume 2 (description)
- Attachment 1: Reactor Coolant System (RCS) table changes
- Attachment 2: Engineered Safety Feature (ESF) table changes
- Attachment 3: Auxiliary Systems table changes
- Attachment 4: Steam and Power Conversion System (SPC) table changes
- Attachment 5: Structures and Component Supports table changes
- Attachment 6: Electrical Components table changes
