SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO APRIL 29, 2003, ORDER REQUIRING COMPLIANCE WITH REVISED DESIGN BASIS THREAT (DBT) FOR OPERATING POWER REACTORS (EA-03-086) FOR BROWNS FERRY NUCLEAR PLANT (BFN), UNITS 1, 2, AND 3; SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT (SQN), UNITS 1 AND 2; AND WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN), UNIT 1

The NRC issued an Order dated April 29, 2003, Requiring Compliance with Revised Design Basis Threat ("Order EA-03-086" or "Order") and other security-related Orders (collectively "Orders") for BFN, SQN, and WBN.

Section III.A of Order EA-03-086 required licensees to submit revised Physical Security Plans, Training and Qualification Plans, and Safequard Contingency Plans to meet the requirements of the revised DBT, along with an implementation schedule, to the Commission for review and approval on April 29, 2004. As required, on April 29, 2004, each site (BFN, SQN, and WBN) submitted their revised plans for review and approval.

Attachment A to each site's submittal contained the revised plans. TVA developed these plans to be consistent with NEI-03-12, "Template for the Security Plan, Training and Qualification Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan, [and Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation Security Program]."
