Dear Mr. Newton:

We have received your submittal of March 4, 2004 regarding the above referenced project. Based on the documentation provided, it is not possible to determine that the fisherman's shed is not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. We recommend that a qualified architectural historian prepare a NPS 10-900 form for the property and submit it to our office for review and comment.

As pointed out in our letter of January 6, 2004, it is not possible to determine if project activities, including leased property under cultivation are having an adverse effect on unidentified archeological sites within the proposed project area. As I mentioned in our telephone conversation, there would be two options regarding archeological sites. First, you could complete an archeological survey for all projects lands pursuant to 36 CFR 800.4 or we could develop a Memorandum of Agreement that would detail how and when archeological surveys would be completed for land management activities.

We look forward to working with you to complete the Section 106 review process in a timely manner. If you would like to discuss these matters in greater detail, please call me at (608) 264-6507.
