Supplemental Response to the April 29, 2003, Orders - Request for Information

The purpose of this submittal is to provide the NRC with information requested during recent conference calls regarding the Florida Power & Light (FPL) and FPL Energy Seabrook, LLC (FPL Energy Seabrook) letter L-2004-107 dated April 29, 2004. Specifically, FPL/FPL Energy Seabrook were requested to provide additional information regarding the "Evaluation Criteria For Determining Equivalency Of Alternatives" within the Physical Security Plan (PSP) that was submitted in the aforementioned letter. Additionally, FPL/FPL Energy Seabrook were requested to provide a cross-reference matrix to site-specific references contained in the PSP.

The information on the subject of Alternatives is provided in addition to the information in Attachment E, Alternative Approaches, to the FPL/FPL Energy Seabrook submittal dated April 29, 2004. This information is in keeping with the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) templates on this subject. The cross-reference matrix is a newly created document that is provided as a roadmap for the staff's review of the PSP.
