1. PPA is the Legislative Activities Consultant to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors in the Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("Debtor") bankruptcy case. 2 8. Pursuant to this Court's "SECOND AMENDED ORDER ESTABLISHING
3 INTERIM FEE APPLICATION AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE" which
4 was entered on or about March 18, 2002, the Debtor is authorized to make the payment requested
5 herein without a further hearing or order of this Court unless an objection to this Application is
6 filed with the Court by the Debtor or the United States Trustee and served by the fifteenth day of
7 the month following the service of this Application. If such an objection is filed, Debtor is
8 authorized to pay the amounts, if any, not subject to the objection. This Cover Sheet Application
9 was mailed by first class mail, postage prepaid, on or about April 30, 2004.

10 9. The interim compensation sought in this Application is on account and is not
11 final. Upon the conclusion of this case, PPA will seek fees and reimbursement of the expenses
12 incurred for the totality of the services rendered in the case. Any interim fees or reimbursement
13 of expenses approved by this Court and received by PPA will be credited against such final fees
14 and expenses as may be allowed by this Court.

15 10. PPA represents and warrants that its billing practices comply with all
16 Northern District of California Bankruptcy Local Rules and Compensation Guidelines and the
17 Guidelines of the Office of the United States Trustee. Neither PPA nor any members of PPA has
18 any agreement or understanding of any kind or nature to divide, pay over or share any portion of
19 the fees or expenses to be awarded to PPA with any other person or attorney except as among the
20 members and associates of PPA.

1 WHEREFORE, PPA respectfully requests that the Debtor pay compensation to PPA
2 as requested herein pursuant to and in accordance with the terms of the "SECOND AMENDED
3 ORDER ESTABLISHING INTERIM FEE APPLICATION AND EXPENSE
4 REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE."
