- NRC supports continuing Ohio staff involvement in NRC inspections
- Ottawa County significantly involved in restart oversight
- NRC has responded to several thousand letters and emails from concerned individuals

Davis-Besse Oversight Activities

Panel Recommends Confirmatory Order at Restart

- Concerns with Self Assessment Capability
- Requires independent outside assessment
- Areas include safety culture, engineering, corrective actions, operations
- Mid-cycle Outage Related Activities



Oversight Should Restart be Authorized

- Provide around-the-clock inspection of start-up activities
- Davis-Besse Oversight Panel will continue to assess FirstEnergy performance and guide NRC actions
- Order-related Additional Inspection
- Additional inspection will be conducted as necessary to address areas where performance indicators are not informative and to ensure corrective actions remain effective
- Resident inspection staff has been augmented



Conclusions

- NRC has taken significant action to ensure FirstEnergy addresses the causes of their poor performance
- NRC provided extensive opportunity for stakeholder and public involvement

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
