Joan:

We received the faxed response from Dr. Stobie today. Based on this and our discussions on April 30, we have a few additional questions:

- 1) Have you determined whether you would like to be licensed for use of low activity I-131 capsules for use as bioassay reference sources?
- 2) How will you assess the effectiveness of radiation safety training provided to your staff? Possible methods are a written quiz or observation of your work by your RSO.
- 3) Is there a specific area of the attic where you will store boxes of waste for 16 days before moving them to the outdoor storage area for a minimum of 64 additional days? For example, will this be directly outside the I-131 room, along the same wall as the countertop and cabinets? Is this portion of the attic secured from unauthorized access?

Aside from these questions, we have all of the information needed to issue the license. After we receive Dr. Stobie's written response and he completes his hands-on training on May 24, we should be able to send out the license. You may fax the response to 610-337-5269, referencing mail control 134654.

Please call me with any questions. I will be out of the office on an inspection trip from May 24-28, therefore the first week of June is likely to be the time when we would issue the license.
