Dave:

We are reviewing your 2/27/04 application for amendment. Our reviewer, Tai Huang, has the following comments/questions. Please call me, or Guy Vissing (between 6/7 and 6/18, when I am not in the office), to arrange a conference call to discuss these.

1. The rationale with respect to the technical consideration to relocate the APRM stability settings to the COLR.
2. A succinct description of the process and methodology used to evaluate the COLR stability safety limits on a cycle-specific basis.
3. An example of the new COLR format for either the next cycle (Cycle 20) or a simulated COLR using old values for the last cycle (Cycle 19).

This e-mail aims solely to prepare you and others for the proposed conference call. It does not formally convey an NRC staff position, nor does it formally request for additional information. The disposition of these comments/questions will be discussed in the conference call.
